

Acceptable Use Policy (AUP)

1. Prohibited Uses

2. Sanctions and Restricted Parties

You may not use the Service if you are:

- Located in a jurisdiction subject to UK or international sanctions
- Listed on any UK, EU, or US sanctions list

You may not use the Service for activities that would violate export control laws.

3. Enforcement

We reserve the right to:

- Suspend or terminate accounts
- Remove content

- Restrict access
- Report unlawful activity to authorities

We may take action without prior notice where necessary to protect the Service or comply with law.
